

## Documenting the Prepubertal Female Ano-Genital Exam

**Please remember to document the following:**

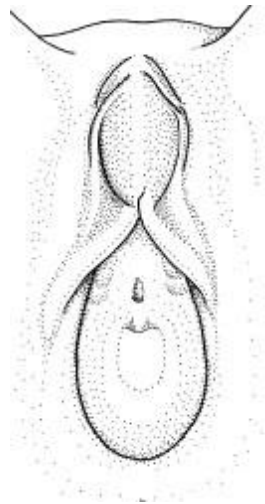
1. Age
2. Sexual Maturity Rating or Tanner Stage

**Draw and label all findings on the diagram: Remember to use the clock position**

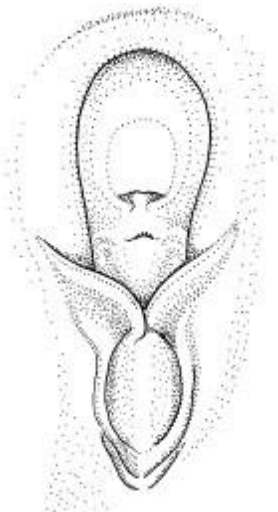
3. Describe the hymen (include if estrogenization present or not)
4. Congenital findings (includes birthmarks, moles, etc.)
5. Scars
6. Traumatic findings (include history: "bit me here", etc)
  - Redness, abrasions, lacerations, bruises, petechiae, swelling, tenderness, pain
7. Other lesions (warts, molluscum, etc)
8. Drainage (Blood, purulent, etc.)
9. Anal Exam (presence of anal wink, laxity, incontinence of stool, trauma, lesions, scars, bleeding, discharge, etc..  
Remember to use the clock position when describing findings.

**Supine (Frog Leg)**

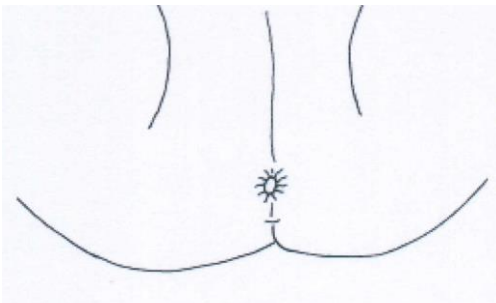


**Knee-Chest (Prone)**
